

Air Crash Investigation

In the area of The Colckhof Estate and Den Alerdinck Estate near Heino a single-engine plane has crashed, without harming anybody. An investigation shows that the plane has left Lelystad Airport in unknown direction. Police say there are suspicious circumstances, which need further investigation. If the plane was stolen, where it was heading for and who was flying it is still unknown, police say, since the pilot has disappeared. An investigation team of the Investigation Safety Board is searching for the black box to reconstruct the accident. They hope to work out what has happened in the near future.

Instruction for the research team

- As a researcher in the research team, we ask you to park on the enclosed parking coordinates. From there, the place of crime is best investigated. Bicycles are not allowed on site.
- In the field we will keep you informed of the information we've found, please read it carefully. All information will be provided in English as well.
- In addition to your usual package, you need to bring two (2) AA batteries and a headset or headphone.
- In addition, we ask you to ensure that the site is not contaminated and that you clean up your pollution as much as possible to avoid disturbance of the investigation. Trash bins can't be found in the field.
- Dogs are allowed, provided that they are leashed.
- Coordinates are to be used in proximity due to the foliage.
- Investigating the entire site takes about 4 kilometres. Thorough research, however, takes a lot of time, take that time.
- Research may take place between dawn and dusk.
- No spoiler pictures or spoiler logs, please but pictures and stories obviously make a log a lot more fun to read.
